



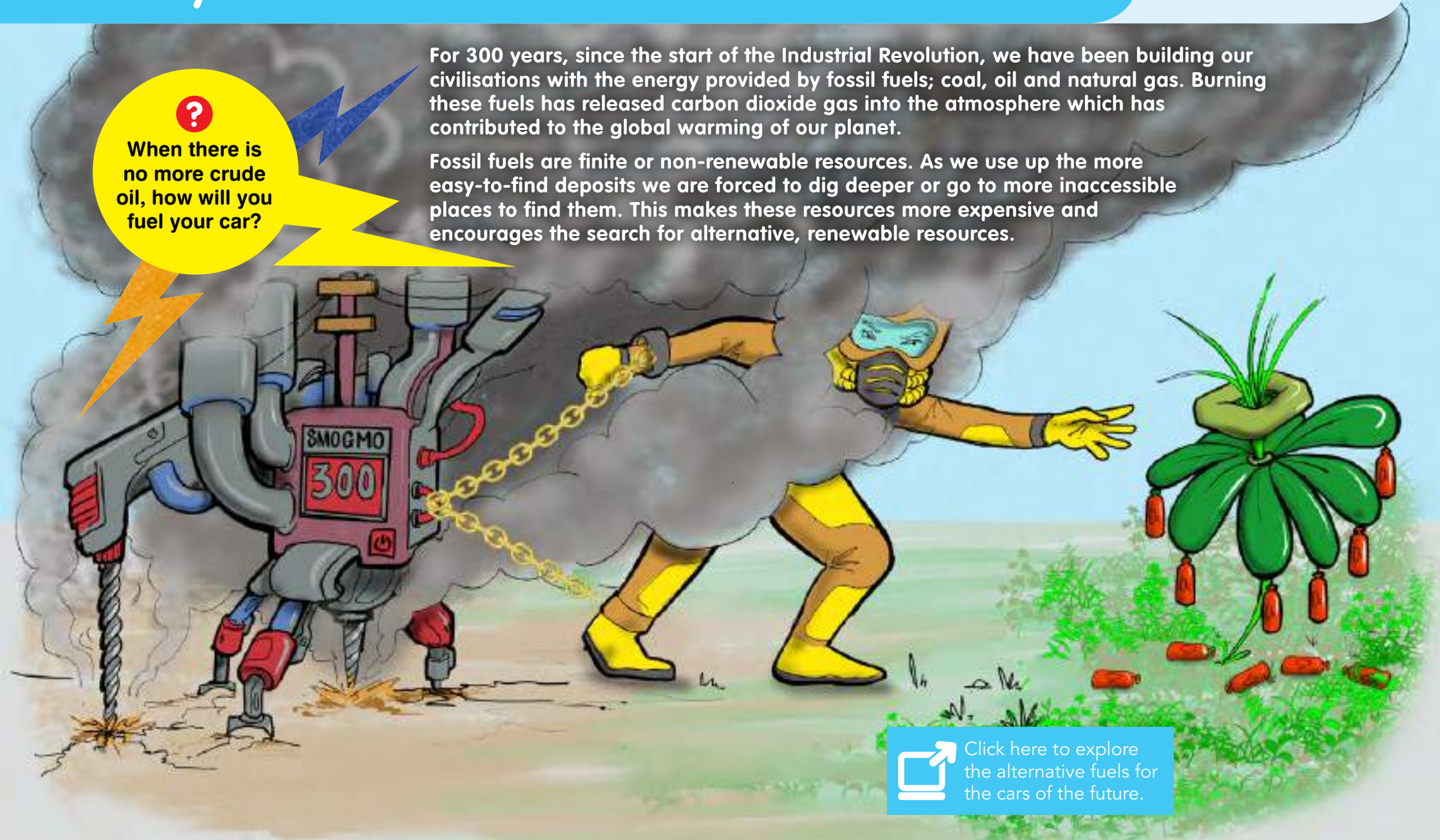
Activity 2.3 Alternative fuels
